

KEY NEW FEATURES SUMMER 2024

A new summer season in Saint-Gervais is the promise of a well-deserved break. Relax, unwind and enjoy a host of rewarding activities.

SOFT MOBILITY, ACT 1

The "Ascenseur des Thermes" is due to open this coming summer. This eco-friendly mode of transport is part of the resorts drive to improve transport services for all, while significantly reducing the environmental impact by using new innovative technology. How does it work? The lift links the main villages within resort and is designed for use by visitors to the thermal baths, schoolchildren, workers or holidaymakers, as well as families and sports lovers. The ingenuity of the lift lies in the way it operates, using domestic wastewater. Running up and down, between Saint-Gervais and Le Fayet, the facility is powered by counterweights and electricity produced and stored during the descent. The residents of Saint-Gervais and Le Fayet owe this idea to Michaël Farmer, the passionate British engineer behind the miniature locomotive in the Thermal Park. This new lift, a direct line of transport between the Thermal Park in Le Fayet and the village of Saint-Gervais, will provide greater freedom of movement.

SOFT MOBILITY, ACT 2

From one lift to another! This summer marks the opening of a new gondola lift known as "Le Valléen", a facility that aims to improve mobility between the different villages in resort. With an average passenger flow of 1,250 people per hour, this new means of transport promises to relieve traffic congestion on the road between Le Fayet and Saint-Gervais. The lift will also reduce CO₂ emissions by around 15%, an added bonus! The new gondola will run between the multi-modal transport hub (train and bus station, tramway, cycle route, car-pooling and hitchhiking) and the Bettex gondola, which is also being replaced by a more energy-efficient upgrade. The facility will ensure low-carbon mobility in keeping with new forms of transport that Saint-Gervais is keen to develop. The key to less pollution and a more sustainable economy.



A NEW LEASE OF LIFE FOR THE THERMAL PARK

A leafy haven in the heart of the village of Le Fayet, the Thermal Park is due to undergo major improvements to restore it to its former glory, with less tarmac and more pedestrian areas! The resort of Saint-Gervais has opted to redesign the grounds to create a more natural environment for residents and holidaymakers alike. 



LE VALLÉEN (VALLEY LIFT): A NEW GENERATION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT

"Le Valléen" is the promise of a year-round alternative means of transport, designed to enhance the current transport options available to local residents and tourists. This facility, the latest generation in urban cableway transport, boasts a high-speed capacity of up to 2,600 passengers per hour. In 2024, the Valley lift will link the town of Saint-Gervais to the hamlet of Le Fayet, encouraging tourism and economic development. An innovative project for the future of Saint-Gervais that will transform the local community and contribute to a greener, more eco-friendly resort.

ASCENSEUR DES THERMES: A REVOLUTIONARY AND ECOFRIENDLY INNOVATION

A new and innovative lift that symbolises the revival of soft, low-carbon mobility is about to make its debut in the Thermal Park. The "Ascenseur des Thermes", formerly known as the "wastewater lift", aims to provide a no-pollution link between the park in Le Fayet and the centre of Saint-Gervais and to improve communication and interaction between local residents. An innovative eco-friendly system has made this feat possible. Inspired by early 20th century techniques and developed by British engineer Michael Farmer, the lift is a successful combination of both tradition and modernity. This ingenious hydraulic mechanism, powered by a counterweight and a ballast tank, runs on wastewater from the public mains network. Completely free of charge and able to carry up to 16 people per trip, it will take just 1.5 minutes to ride the 255 metres between the upper and lower villages.

"FLOCON VERT" PROTECTING NATURE FOR A GREENER FUTURE



The "Flocon Vert" environmental certification has been developed to encourage and reward those ski resorts in France actively committed to respecting the ecosystem and biodiversity. Saint-Gervais engages in the safeguard of nature and strives on a daily basis to reduce the environmental impact of both sports and tourism related industries in the area. As a reward for its efforts, the resort was awarded 2 out of 3

Plus, to continue its educational role amongst the general public, the local authority runs regular awaremess campaigns on the importance of the surrounding environment, encouraging visitors to adopt responsible behaviour.

MONT-BLANC TRAMWAY, A GENTLE RIDE TO THE SUMMIT

The highest cog railway in France is currently undergoing extensive improvements. This summer. work on the Tramway du Mont-Blanc will result in a terminus at Mont-Lachat instead of the Nid d'Aigle. A timeless experience and the perfect opportunity for visitors to discover alpine scenery at the foot of the majestic Mont-Blanc. Although 3 trains a day will serve a temporary stop at the Nid d'Aigle, access to these trains is reserved for mountaineers on their climb to Mont-Blanc or for those who have booked an overnight stay in a mountain refuge.

Producing clean energy is one of the major challenges facing the resort of Saint-Gervais.

To support its existing efforts (solar panels, photovoltaic power station etc.) and expand its fleet of hydroelectric power stations (3 presently in operation: Le Fayet, Bionnay, Râteau), the Miage micro-hydroelectric water turbine will be commissioned this autumn.

The waters from the Miage torrent will contribute to the production of this "new" source of energy. To avoid excessive pollution linked to the transportation of tools and materials, so-called "green works" will be undertaken to complete this project transport by cable, without fuel. Plus, to reduce visual pollution, the power station building has been designed to intergrate the surrounding environment.



Looking to discover the Bonnant gorges? Somewhere between hiking and rock climbing,
Via Ferrata is the ideal choice.
Starting from the park in Le Fayet, experienced climbers can wind their way along the rock face.
For this vertical route, rated AD+ (very difficult), it is advisable to be accompanied by a professional. An exciting experience for thrill-seekers!

IN WARRIOR MODE

Apprentice Ninjas can enjoy a fun and **exciting experience** at 1,800m altitude, opposite Mont-Blanc. Open to adventure seekers of all ages, this 70-metre **obstacle course boasts**

a zip line, ropes an inclined wall and balance modules.

IN FREESTYLE MODE

Saint-Gervais boasts an adventure playground for **freestyle enthusiasts**. Three different facilities include: a 550 sq-m skatepark with a bowl and modules for skateboard fans, a bikepark equipped with numerous wooden modules and tracks and a pumptrack.

IN ELECTRIC MODE

Discover the resort's historical heritage and natural resources on an electric mountain bike.

This new activity, proposed by Julien - an engineer, mountain leader and certified trainer/guide - offers outdoor enthusiasts the perfect opportunity to combine pleasure, effort and safety. Plus, those interested can participate in a bike maintenance workshop and learn how to repair and maintain their bikes.

CLIMB HIGHER, FASTER!

Fancy a picnic at the summit, a walk or a mountain bike ride? **During the summer season, the mountain lifts** enable visitors to access the heights, enjoy the views and discover the natural surroundings along the different trails. Special packages, group rates and the gratuity for children under 5 means that everyone can enjoy the experience. Opening dates and further information available from the Tourist Information Office.

Please note: this summer, the Saint-Gervais – Le Bettex gondola lift is closed for renovation works However, the gondola from Le Bettex to Mont d'Arbois (1,850 m) will be running as usual (hiking, mountain biking, Ninja course, mountain restaurants etc.).



VAL MONTJOIE, ROUND AND ABOUT

This 5-day trek through the Val Montjoie, between Saint-Gervais Mont-Blanc and Les Contamines-Montjoie, is an immersive experience amidst natural surroundings. In solo or under the supervision of a guide, each day offers breathtaking panoramic views, from mountain pastures to unspoilt forests. Unique moments, such as the descent towards the Miage mountain pasture or the climb to Mont Joly with its breathtaking panorama, highlight this hike. The last stage, through the ancient mountain pastures of Saint-Nicolas de Véroce, is the perfect conclusion to this memorable adventure.

TREE TOP ADVENTURE TRAIL, A CASCADE OF ZIP WIRES

The mountain guides of Saint-Gervais / Les Contamines are expanding the tree top adventure trail in Le Fayet with the creation of a new course. Works are due to take place over a two-year period. This new thrill-seeking circuit will feature over 600 m of zip wires, divided into 8 sections, through the forest. Open from early summer to late autumn, this moderately challenging activity is open to everyone. Enjoy a thrilling adventure through the trees, at full speed!

NB: during the works, the 5 existing courses and the toddler course will remain open.

LUMBERJACK FESTIVAL ON 1ST SEPTEMBER!

Equipped with their favourite chainsaws, lumberjacks will gather in the park in Le Fayet for a lively day of entertainment.

On the programme: wood sculpting, music, local crafts, a car boot sale and an antiques market. Fun for all the family!

THERMAL PARK IN LE FAYET, A MORE NATURAL SETTING IN THE HEART OF THE VILLAGE

The park in Le Fayet is due to undergo a major redevelopment programme, backed by the French government as part of the Plan Avenir Montagne (Future for the Mountain Scheme). The local council aims to restore the park to its original state, its historic roots. The work will include refurbishing the pedestrian walkways to make them accessible to people with disabilities as well as redesigning the parking areas (more spacious, equipped with electric recharging points), making them more eco-friendly and easily accessible. On higher ground, new picnic areas with panoramic views will dot the footpaths.

The entrance to the park will be redesigned to restore the historic

The entrance to the park will be redesigned to restore the historic gateway to its former glory whilst the main avenue, bordered with majestic lime trees, will portray a softer, **more welcoming atmosphere.**





From the car park at La Gruvaz, take the path leading to Maison Neuve, through forests and clearings, towards the Alpage du Truc. On arrival. tuck into a selection of cheeses and sausages at the Auberge du Truc where breathtaking views of the Mont Joly and the Dômes du Miage can be enjoyed.

DRÉ DANS L'PENTU

Starting from Le Bettex, this walk is guaranteed to whet your appetite! Take a detour via the Pierre du Déjeuner mountain pasture to reach the route des Orgères and enjoy a selection of cow's and goat's milk cheeses at the La Grand Montaz.
